Studies on all organisms as well as on human cells and tissues are welcome.

Folia Biologica welcomes all authors who wish to publish novel findings in the areas of metabolism, development, molecular genetics, genome organization and function, molecular evolution, gene expression, genomic and computational biology, structural biology, signal transduction, cell and tissue architecture and function, molecular and cellular biology of disease and molecular medicine.

The journal Folia Biologica is published by The Charles University in Prague - The 1st Faculty of Medicine and it is devoted to the advancement and dissemination of fundamental knowledge of cellular and molecular aspects of biology and medicine.

The submission of a paper implies that it reports unpublished work and that it is not under consideration for publication elsewhere.

Full-length papers, short communications, and focused review articles are published. Authors who wish to submit a review article should contact the Editorial office first since all reviews are by invitation only.

All contributions are in English.

General Requirements: Manuscripts submitted to the journal must represent reports of original research, and the original data must be available for review by the editor if requested. Submitting a manuscript to Folia Biologica implies that the manuscript is as a whole or any of its part not under consideration elsewhere.
